HOUSE RULES

1. No smoking in the house. Smoking is allowed on the lower porch only.
2. No one is allowed in the kitchen, barn or laundry areas without permission.
3. **No Pets Allowed on the Decks, Patios or in the House.** Any Pets must be on a Leash attended to by their Owners. Owners shall clean up after the Pets.
4. All parties must end by 10:30 PM.
5. No discharging of firearms, explosive devices or fireworks.
6. Proper attire is required for Thursday dinners:
Men: Resort casual *Women:* No tank tops or short shorts
7. Ice for coolers and off-premise use can only be taken from the ice machine in the kitchen, after receiving staff permission.
8. Members may not intrude on private parties, but may use the bar and porch areas in a non-intrusive manner.
9. Members shall conduct themselves in a courteous manner and promote good fellowship at all times. **Parents are responsible for the actions and safety of their children.** Parents are expected to know the whereabouts of their children and enforce the Club rules. Members are responsible for the safety and behavior of their guests.
10. Music, radio or television must not disturb other guests.
11. Members must bus their own plates, glasses, garbage, etc.. There is a tray in the bar area for dirty dishes.
12. Bikes may be locked in the barn, but not together or to the bike rack. The owner's name must be clearly marked on all bikes. Bikes that are not properly marked or are improperly locked will be removed and sold. No bikes or gas containers may be stored under the house.
13. Accounts not paid in full will be brought to the executive committee for action.
14. The continental breakfast is only for members and guests staying in the house.
15. Conduct which is disruptive or inappropriate may result in the suspension of member privileges when deemed necessary by the board of directors. Members under suspension may be restricted as to their use of the club.
16. No complaints are to be directed to any staff other than the club manager.
17. No more than six (6) guests may be brought to the club at any one time by a member without advance notice to the manager.
